Call to Worship with words from Psalm 4:

P: Answer me when I call, O God of my right!

C: You gave me room when I was in distress.

P: Be gracious to me, and hear my prayer.

C: How long, you people, shall my honor suffer shame?

P: How long will you love vain words, and seek after lies?

C: But know that the Lord has set apart the faithful for himself;

P: the Lord hears when I call to him.

C: When you are disturbed, do not sin; ponder it on your beds, and be silent.

P: Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the Lord.

C: Let the light of your face shine on us, O Lord!"

P: I will both lie down and sleep in peace; for you alone,

C: O Lord, make me lie down in safety.

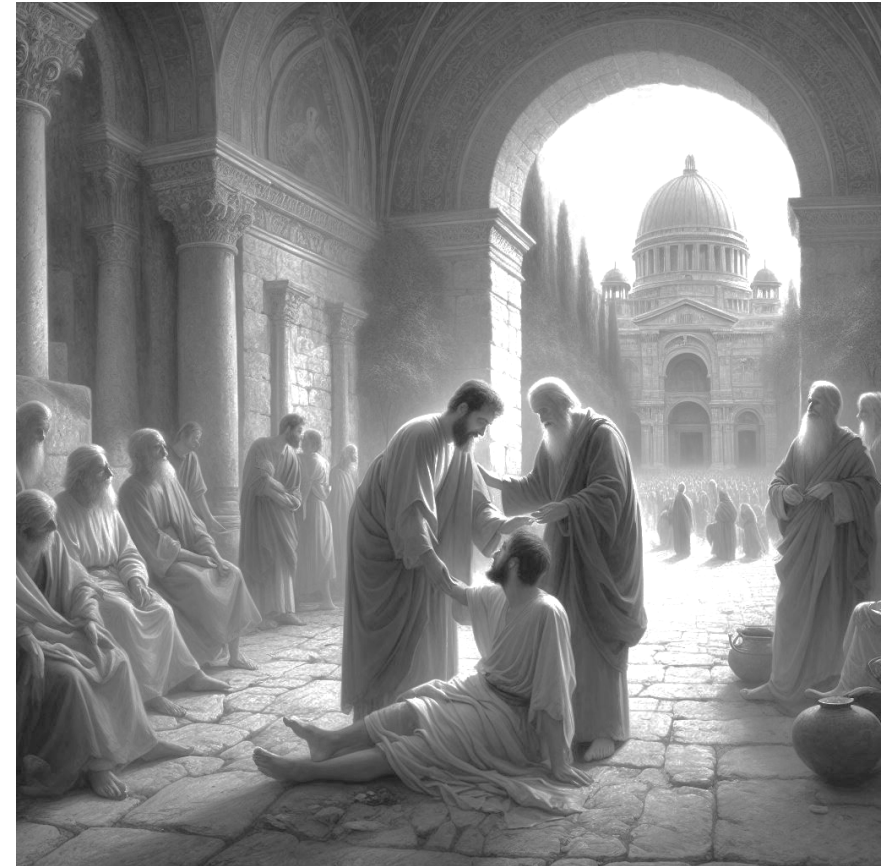
